#### Key Responsibilities

- Carrying out onsite installation & commissioning as a primary function. Carry out preventative maintenance, support, repair and breakdown visits as a secondary function. Both aspects will include travel, stay away over night or, on occasion, work at weekends

- Providing technical, application and trial support and carry out demonstrations primarily on FA/LA products (telephone and site based) to customers, other SICK engineers in the UK or in the SICK SSC03 Cluster (South West Europe) and the SICK Sales Team
